PUBLIC STOCK DONATIONS

The Library accepts publicly traded stock, bond and mutual fund shares through its brokerage account at Vanguard. Contact the Library for more information.

MAKE A PLEDGE

Capital Campaign pledges may be paid up to three years, payable monthly, quarterly or annually. For instance, a \$1,000 pledge may be paid through monthly online donations of \$42 over two years. A pledge can be set up with email reminders if requested. Pledge forms are available on our website.

WORKPLACE GIVING

Workplace giving is an easy and efficient way to make tax-deductible donations to the Library through payroll deductions.

Memorial gifts may be designated for family or friends to affirm the value of libraries and lifelong learning. A notice of all gifts is sent to the family and the amount of gifts is confidential. A gift to the Library is also a unique way to honor an anniversary, birthday or special event.

EMPLOYER MATCHING GIFTS

Many area employers, including Boeing, QVC and SAP will match charitable donations made by their employees throughout the year. Contact your employer and ask about matching gifts.
